that was completed before another past action Mastering these requires careful consideration of context and time relationships II Modal Verbs Expressing Possibility Necessity and Permission Modal verbs can could may might must should will would are auxiliary verbs that express a speakers attitude towards the action or state of being Understanding their nuances is critical for conveying meaning accurately PossibilityProbability May and might express possibility could indicates past possibility or present possibility considered less likely NecessityObligation Must expresses strong necessity should suggests a weaker obligation or recommendation PermissionRequest Can and could express permission or make requests may is a more formal way to ask for permission The subtle differences in meaning between these modals often hinge on context and the speakers intended emphasis III Passive Voice Shifting the Focus The passive voice formed using be past participle shifts the focus from the actor subject to the action itself.
