




















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with stakes in film television theme parks and merchandising disney continues to be one of the most dominant forces of popular culture around the globe films produced by the studio are usually blockbusters in nearly every country where they are released however despite

their box office success these films often generate as much disdain as admiration while appreciated for their visual aesthetics many of these same films are criticized for their cultural insensitivity or lack of historical fidelity in debating disney pedagogical perspectives on commercial cinema douglas brode and shea t brode have assembled a collection of essays that examine disney s output from the 1930s through the present day each chapter in this volume represents the conflicting viewpoints of contributors who look at disney culture from a variety of perspectives covering both animated and live action films as well as television programs these essays discuss how the studio handles social issues such as race gender and culture as well as its depictions of science and history though some of the essays in this volume are critical of individual films or television shows they also acknowledge the studio s capacity to engage audiences with the quality of their work these essays encourage readers to draw their own conclusions about disney productions allowing them to consider the studio as the hero as much as the villain in the cultural deliberation debating disney will be of interest to scholars and students of film as well as those with an interest in popular culture

the untold succession struggle at walt disney productions following the death of its founder and the generational transformation which led to the birth of the modern multibillion dollar animation industry walt disney left behind big dreams when he died in 1966 perhaps none was greater than the hope that his son in law ron miller would someday run his studio under miller s leadership disney expanded into new frontiers global theme parks computer animation cable television home video and video games despite these innovations ron struggled to expand the disney brand beyond its midcentury image of wholesome family entertainment even as times and tastes evolved tensions between miller and walt s nephew roy e disney threatened to destroy the company leading wall street gordon gekko types to come after mickey mouse at the same time the aging animation department once the core of walt s business was one memo away from shutting down forever rather thanks to the radical efforts of walt s veterans to recruit and nurture young talent it was revived by this sudden influx of artists who would go on to revolutionize the film industry additionally this new generation would prove over time that animation was so much more than just kids stuff it was a multibillion dollar industry this is the upstairs downstairs story of the executives and animators who clashed and collaborated to keep america s most storied company alive during the most uncertain period in its one hundred year history

throughout its long and colorful history walt disney studios has produced scores of films designed to educate moviegoers as well as entertain them these productions range from the true life adventures nature documentaries and such depictions of cutting edge technology as man in space and our friend the atom to wartime propaganda shorts education for death public health films vd attack plan and coverage of exotic cultures the ama girls blue men of morocco even disney s dramatic recreations of historical events ten who dared invincible have had their share of educational value each of the essays in this volume focuses on a different type of disney edutainment film together they provide the first comprehensive look at walt disney s ongoing mission to inform and enlighten his worldwide audience

upholds a disney vacation as a religious experience offers insightful arguments relating to the nature of play as well as nietzschean philosophy reading religion rituals mark significant moments in our lives perhaps none more significant than moments of lightheartedness joy and play rituals of play are among the most sacred of any of the rites in which humanity may engage although we may fail to recognize them they are always present in culture providing a kind of psychological release for their participants child and adult alike disneyland is an example of the kind of container necessary for the construction of rituals of play this work explores the original disney theme park in anaheim as a temple cult it challenges the disciplines of mythological studies religious studies film studies and depth psychology to broaden traditional definitions of the kind of cultural apparatus that constitute temple culture and ritual it does so by suggesting that hollywood s entertainment industry has developed a platform for mythic ritual after setting the ritualized stage this book turns to the practices in disneyland proper analyzing the patron s traditions within the framework of the park and beyond it explores disneyland s spectacles through selected shows and parades and concludes with an exploration of the park s participation in ritual renewal there is much to commend in koehler s study surely her work should encourage others to examine myth construction and sacred secular rituals in popular culture h celebration

many disney films adapt works from the victorian period which is often called the golden age of children s literature animating the victorians disney s literary history explores disney s adaptations of victorian texts like alice in wonderland oliver twist treasure island peter pan and the tales of hans christian andersen author patrick c fleming traces those adaptations from initial concept to theatrical release and

beyond to the sequels consumer products and theme park attractions that make up a disney franchise during the production process which often extended over decades disney s writers engaged not just with the texts themselves but with the contexts in which they were written their authors biographies and intervening adaptations to reveal that process fleming draws on preproduction reports press releases and unfinished drafts including materials in the walt disney company archives some of which have not yet been discussed in print but the relationship between disney and the victorians goes beyond adaptations walt disney himself had a similar career to the victorian author entrepreneur charles dickens linking the disney princess franchise to victorian ideologies shows how gender and sexuality are constantly being renegotiated disney s animated musicals theme parks copyright practices and even marketing campaigns depend on cultural assumptions legal frameworks and media technologies that emerged in nineteenth century england moreover disney s adaptations influence modern students and scholars of the victorian period by applying scholarship in victorian studies to a global company fleming shows how institutions mediate our understanding of the past and demonstrates the continued relevance of literary studies in a corporate media age

what s your happy place if you said a disney theme park you re in good company journalist and film critic scott renschow profiles some remarkable people who have let the disney theme parks take over their lives in a healthy way of course and examines why disney holds such primacy in our culture

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in living in the landscape arnold berleant explores new ways of thinking about how we live and might live in the landscapes that enfold us through the concepts of aesthetic engagement and environmental continuity he proposes a new paradigm that offers a holistic approach to the meaning of place and places of meaning in our lives although environmental aesthetics is linked in the popular mind to dramatic vistas and monumental landscapes the grand canyon for example berleant is much more concerned with the commonplace settings of everyday life he argues that our active appreciation of or aesthetic engagement with the prosaic landscapes of home work local travel and recreation plays a vital role in our discovery of hidden continuities as well as pleasure and meaning in the places we inhabit berleant begins with a general introduction to environmental aesthetics identifying the kinds of experience meanings and values it involves and describing its historical sources and the issues with which it is concerned in the rest of the book he spotlights new directions in the field as they relate to education community creativity and the sacred and provides an insightful analysis of negative environmental aesthetics throughout he is both thoughtful and entertaining as evidenced in his extended critique of the pop post modern environment of disney world berleant

addresses issues commonly associated with the environmental movement e g preservation pollution control and quality of life but his study draws from a wide range of disciplines and for that reason should also appeal to scholars and students interested in art and aesthetics landscape architecture and planning urban and environmental design and cultural geography as well as environmental studies

branded a cultural chernobyl and the tragic kingdom the euro disney resort has been on its own thrill ride since opening in 1992 the much publicized version of the magic kingdom gave europeans alcohol free mocktails surly employees even colors too muted for the disney image facing financial disaster was it any wonder that disney execs found themselves wishing upon a star for answers after so many knee jerk criticisms of euro disney this book combines firsthand experience and research to shed new light on claims that the park is nothing more than a form of american cultural imperialism andrew lainsbury a former euro disney employee who knows what the park meant to its visitors goes beyond media bites and academic scorn to examine europe s love hate relationship with euro disneyland and some of the undiscussed issues surrounding it once upon an american dream is a story of global capitalism on a grand scale lainsbury has plumbed company archives and interviewed key players to give readers the real view from le chateau de la belle au bois dormant sleeping beauty s castle he cracks open the euro disney controversy to reveal the park not as a tragic experiment in exporting american culture but the result of european efforts to import a popular form of american entertainment lainsbury tells how the walt disney company came to build a european park and locate it in france how political negotiations affected its design and development how it was promoted to continental audiences and what caused its widely publicized financial woes before being rescued by a real prince from saudi arabia he reveals what it took to win back the hearts of skeptical europeans such as serving wine selling flashy merchandise and placating disgruntled workers finally he looks into the magic mirror to speculate on the role of euro disney and the walt disney company in the twenty first century ultimately lainsbury shows that cultural imperialism is not an exclusively american phenomenon but a global corporate strategy and that global corporatism by needing to be responsive to consumers is so complex that it may not be as monolithic as feared once upon an american dream is a fairy tale for our times reminding us that for all the critical huffing and puffing the creation and marketing of pleasure is what euro disneyland is all about

la couverture indique alan nadel s new book reminds us that most of the images on early tv were decidedly caucasian and directed at predominantly white audiences television did not invent whiteness for america but it did reinforce it as the norm particularly during the cold war years nadel now shows just how instrumental it was in constructing a narrow conservative and very white vision of america during this era prime time tv was dominated by adult westerns with heroes like the rebel s johnny yuma reincarnating southern values and bonanza s cartwright family reinforcing the notion of white patriarchy programs that nadel shows bristled with cold war messages even as they spoke to the nation s mythology america had become visually reconfigured as a vast ponderosa crisscrossed by concrete highways designed to carry suburban white drivers beyond the moral challenge of racism racial poverty and increasingly vocal civil rights demands
