the hispanic baroque is a janus faced phenomenon one of its faces peering at the sunset of feudalism the other at the dawn of european modernity this collection of essays seeks to engage with this paradox and its consequences for understanding spanish and latin american literary and cultural history

language in the schools integrating linguistic knowledge into k 12 teaching addresses two important questions what aspects of linguistic knowledge are most useful for teachers to know what kinds of activities and projects are most effective in introducing those aspects of linguistic knowledge to k 12 students the volume focuses on how basic linguistic knowledge can inform teachers approaches to language issues in the multicultural linguistically diverse classroom the text also includes examples of practical applications of language awareness to pedagogy assessment and curriculum construction which support the current goals of language arts bilingual and esl education language in the schools integrating linguistic knowledge into k 12 teaching contributes to the resources on linguistics and education by taking prospective teachers beyond basic linguistics to ways in which linguistics can productively inform their teaching and raise their students awareness of language it is intended as a text for students in teacher education programs who have a basic knowledge of linguistics

language as cultural practice mexicanos en el norte offers a vivid ethnographic account of language socialization practices within mexican background families residing in california and texas this account illustrates a variety of cases where language is used by speakers to choose between alternative self definitions and where language interacts differentially with other defining categories such as ethnicity gender and class it shows that language socialization instantiated in language choices and patterns of use in sociocultural and sociohistorical contexts characterized by ambiguity and flux is both a dynamic and a fluid process the study emphasizes the links between familial patterns of language use and language socialization practices on the one hand and children s development of bilingual and biliterate identities on the other using a framework emerging from their selection of two geographically distinct localities with differing demographic features schecter and bayley compare patterns of meaning suggested by the use of spanish and english in speech and literacy activities as well as by the symbolic importance ascribed by families and

societal institutions such as schools to the maintenance and use of the two languages language as cultural practice provides a detailed account of the diversity of language practices and patterns of use in language minority homes offers educators detailed information on the language ecology of latino homes in two geographically diverse communities san antonio texas and the san francisco bay area california shows the diversity within mexican american communities in the united states families profiled range from rural families in south texas to upper middle class professional families in northern california provides data to correct the prevalent misconception that maintenance of spanish interferes with the acquisition of english and contributes to the study of language socialization by showing that the process extends throughout the lifetime and that it is an interactive rather than a one way process this book will particularly interest researchers and professionals in linguistics anthropology applied linguistics and education and will be useful as a text in graduate courses in these areas that address language socialization and learning

this collection opens with an inquiry into the assumptions and methods of the historical study of culture comparing the new cultural history with the old thirteen essays follow each defining a problem within a particular culture in the first section biography and autobiography three scholars explore historically changing types of self conception each reflecting larger cultural meanings essays included examine italian renaissance biographers and the autobiographies of benjamin franklin and mohandas gandhi a second group of contributors explore problems raised by the writing of history itself especially as it relates to a notion of culture here examples are drawn from the writings of thucydides

jacob burckhardt and the art historians alois riegl and josef strzygowski in the third section politics nationalism and culture the essays explore relationships between cultural creativity and national identity with case studies focusing on the holy roman emperor maximilian i the place of castile within the national history of spain and the impact of world war i on work of thomas mann the final section cultural translation raises the complex questions of cultural influence and the transmission of traditions over time through studies of philo of alexandria s interpretation of the hebrew bible erasmus use of socrates jean bodin s conception of roman law and adaptations of the hebrew bible for american children

reconsidering longfellow is the first collection of scholarly essays in several decades devoted entirely to the work and afterlife of the most popular and widely read writer in american literature the essays written by a new generation of longfellow scholars cover the entire range of longfellow s work from the early poetry to the wildly successful epics of his middle period evangeline the song of hiawatha to his chaucerian collection of stories published after the civil war tales of a wayside inn separate contributions discuss longfellow s financial dealings his preoccupation with his children and his interest in the visual arts as well as the tremendous role his poetry did and will once again play in american literature classrooms in the u s all essays were written specifically for the volume many of them rely on unpublished archival sources from the longfellow collections at the longfellow house george washington national historic site and at houghton library in cambridge massachusetts

first published in 2001 this is the first substantial reference work in english on the various forms that constitute life writing as this term suggests the encyclopedia explores not only autobiography and biography proper but also letters diaries memoirs family histories case histories and other ways in which individual lives have been recorded and structured it includes entries on genres and subgenres national and regional traditions from around the world and important auto biographical writers as well as articles on related areas such as oral history anthropology testimonies and the representation of life stories in non verbal art forms

this collection of thirteen specially commissioned essays by international scholars takes a fresh look at the profound impact of the peninsular war on romantic british literature and culture the expertly authored chapters explore the valorization of spain by nineteenth century poets such as lord byron william wordsworth robert southey s t coleridge

the shelleys and felicia hemans in contrast to the enlightenment era view of spain as a backwards nation in decline topics discussed include the vision of spain in gothic fiction spanish experiences of exile as exemplified by the conflict between valentin de llanos and joseph blanco white and british women writers approach to peninsular fiction spain in british romanticism 1800 1840 is essential reading for scholars and enthusiasts of romantic literature and spanish history
