the impacts of business environmental factors on operations strategy choices in a manufacturing context have been heavily researched however how managers of service firms in developing countries such as china develop operations strategy has yet to receive any significant attention among researchers drawing on the manufacturing literature we examine in the chinese context the relationships between business environmental factors such as business cost competitive hostility labour availability and environmental dynamism and operations strategy choices such as low cost quality flexibility and delivery performance employing a path analytic framework we have identified strong linkages between business environment viz business cost competitive hostility and environmental dynamism and operations strategy choices we have found that environmental dynamism such as changes in retail technology and innovations in new service development had the strongest

influence on the degree of emphasis placed on operations strategy choices however environmental concerns about labour availability do not appear to have any direct effect on the operations strategy selections among retail firms in china
