modern Spain 1808 to the present is a comprehensive overview of Spanish history from the Napoleonic era to the present day. It places a large emphasis on Spain's place within broader European and global history. The chronological political narrative is enriched by separate chapters on long-term economic, social, and cultural developments. This presentation of modern Spanish history incorporates the latest thinking on key issues of modernity: social movements, nationalism, democratization, and democracy.

Amongst the serried ranks of capitalists who drove European industrialisation in the nineteenth century, the Rothschilds were amongst the most dynamic and the most successful establishing businesses in Germany, Britain, France, Austria, and Italy. The family soon became leading financiers, bankrolling a host of private and government businesses. Ventures in so doing they played a major role in fuelling economic and industrial development across Europe, providing capital for major projects, particularly in the mining and railway sectors. Nowhere was this more apparent than in Spain, where for more than a century the House of Rothschild was one of the primary motors of Spanish economic development. Yet despite the undoubted importance of the Rothschild's role, questions still remain regarding the actual impact of these financial activities and the effect they had on financial sectors, companies, and Spanish markets. It is to such questions that this book turns its attention, utilising a host of archive sources in Britain, France, and Spain to fully analyse the investments and financial activities carried out by the Rothschild house in Spain during the nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. In so doing, the book tackles a variety of interrelated issues: firstly, fixing the period when the main capital entries sprung from the initiatives taken by the Rothschild family; how consequential they really were and the sectors they affected; secondly, quantifying the importance of these investments and financial activities and the weight they had on financial sectors, companies, and Spanish markets, as well as in foreign investment in each period; thirdly, outlining the steps followed and means used by the Rothschild house in order to achieve the success in each of their businesses; finally, analysing the consequences of this phenomenon in the actual growth of Spanish contemporary economy, both in a general and in a partial scale. By exploring these crucial questions, not only do we learn much more about the working of one of the leading financial institutions and the development of the Spanish economy, but a greater understanding of the broader impact of international finance and the flow of capital in the nineteenth century is achieved.

The figure of the entrepreneur has become a relevant factor that explains the process of growth and economic development. in the 19th and 20th centuries spain was a key player in the military conflagrations that created modern europe from the napoleonic wars through the dress rehearsal for world war ii that was the spanish civil war to the grim struggle against terrorism today the military history of modern spain has both shaped and reflected larger forces beyond its borders this volume traces the course of spanish military history primarily during the 20th century chapter 1 provides the foundation for the role of the spanish army at home the war of independence napoleonic war the carlist wars and pronunciamientos abroad morocco 1859 60 and as an instrument for liberal reforms in spain chapter 2 covers the period following the spanish american war as the army redirected its focus to the spanish protectorate in northern morocco this chapter covers the rif rebellion 1921 27 the dictatorship of miguel primo de rivera 1923 30 and concludes with the end of the monarchy and the establishment of the 2nd republic in 1931 chapters 3 and 4 present the two armies of the spanish civil war as well as their relationship to the warring factions of nationalists and republicans chapter 5 looks at the spanish army during world war ii on the eastern front russia in its overseas colonies as well as in spain de colonialism is covered in chapter 6 as spain following the lead of the other european powers began to shed itself of its african empire chapter 8 charts spain s integration into the western defense community in the 1950s its membership in nato and its participation in peacekeeping and humanitarian missions in the balkans and the middle east chapter 9 focuses on spain s struggle against terrorism both the domestic basques of eta fatherland and liberty and the newer conflict against al qaeda and radical islamic fundamentalism

following spain s transition to democracy in the 1970s the country experienced rapid economic modernization the establishment of a functioning liberal democracy and a cultural renaissance along with rising living standards over the following thirty years ordinary spaniards experienced massive

improvements in the road and rail networks in local amenities from sporting facilities to centers for the aged and in the public health system as a result by the start of the 20th century spaniards had largely overcome any sense of inferiority in comparison with other major western european countries and the united states however spain was hit by a severe economic recession between 2008 and 2011 and unemployment levels are still very high moreover a large number of corruption cases have come to light and tensions between the central government and catalan autonomous government have burst into open conflict restructuring the spanish economy ensuring probity in public life and accommodating catalonia within the spanish state are therefore key tasks in the decade the lies ahead this third edition of the historical dictionary of spain contains a chronology an introduction appendixes and an extensive bibliography the dictionary section has more than 700 cross referenced entries on important personalities as well as aspects of the country s politics economy foreign relations religion and culture the book is an excellent resource for students researchers and anyone wanting to know more about spain

that have often surrounded the history of Spain by offering an analysis within a European context he also challenges the traditional view of the exceptional character of the country encapsulated in the motto Spain is different on the contrary this book so convincingly contends Spain is a perfect example to show the troubled and often violent path to modernity that Western societies had to undergo in their transition from elite to mass politics

This work analyses the Spanish experience of the First World War in terms of the general crisis in Europe at this time in Spain as elsewhere the impact of four years of devastating conflict resulted in ideological militancy economic dislocation and social struggle the author examines the slow decay of the ruling liberal monarchy during the war years and the failure of the neutrality policy to save the existing regime he looks at challenges to the administration from the labour movement the bourgeoisie the army international powers Romero shows a politically apathetic population galvanised by the war into fierce debate about belligerence or neutrality the debate divides the nation and the new political awareness leads to a questioning of the administration's authority there is also vast economic and social change as Spain exploits its privileged position as supplier to both sides of the war these factors lead to galloping inflation civil unrest and political turmoil finally resulting in the revolutionary strike of 1917

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Old troubles with remote origins persist in modern Spain including huge public debts extensive corruption widespread unlawfulness oligarchical politics territorial splits and permanent protests and riots when did Spain screw up the Spanish frustration provides an interpretation of several important aspects of present day Spain and its past stories it argues that in the long term Spain missed the opportunity to become a consolidated modern nation state because it was entangled in imperial adventures for several centuries when it should have been building a solid domestic basis for further endeavors in

short a ruinous empire made a weak state which built an incomplete nation which sustains a minority democracy

nineteenth century spain deserves wider readership bedevilled by lost empires wars political instability and frustrated modernisation the country appeared backward in relation to northern europe and even in relation to much of its own geographical periphery this new history the first survey of its kind in english in more than a hundred years offers a fresh perspective on this century showing how and why elements of backwardness and modernity ran in parallel through spain bounded by the military and imperial crises of 1808 and 1898 this study pays special attention to the experience of war on politics and society and integrates the latest historical debates in its analysis

the twin focus of this book is on the importance of the spanish heritage on nation and state building in nineteenth century spanish speaking latin america alongside processes of nation and state building in spain and latin america rather than concentrating purely on nationalism and national identity the book explores the linkages that remained or were re established between spain and her former colonies as has increasingly been recognised in recent decades the nineteenth century world was marked by the rise of the modern nation state but also by the development of new transnational connections and this book accounts for these processes within a hispanic context

at the turn of the century armando palacio valdes 1853 1938 enjoyed the reputation of being one of spain s leading novelists widely translated into other languages he was hailed enthusiastically by such foreign critics as edmund gosse and william dean howells in the twentieth century he was regarded as a safe novelist the paladin of middle class catholic virtues recently however his novels are again attracting interest in spain in spain s forgotten novelist brian j dendle critically examines palacio valdes s career and reputation casting doubt on his benign image and veracity and establishing that the sales of palacio valdes s books in translation were much less than the author claimed

it was during the period 1913 1923 that the seeds of political polarization and social violence culminating in the spanish civil war were sown this volume explores the causes of the growing schism within spanish society focusing on the crisis of the spanish liberal order under challenge from newly mobilized forces on both the right and left

the bestselling author of stalingrad and berlin the downfall on the spanish civil war drawing on masses of newly discovered material from the spanish russian and german archives the civil war that tore spain apart between 1936 and 1939 and attracted liberals and socialists from across the world to support the cause against franco was one of the most hard fought and bitterest conflicts of the 20th century a war of atrocities and political genocide and a military testing ground before wwii for the russians italians and germans whose condor legion so notoriously destroyed guernica antony beevor s account narrates the origins of the civil war and its violent and dramatic course from the coup d etat in july 1936 through the savage fighting of the next three years which ended in catastrophic defeat for the republicans in 1939 and he succeeds especially well in unravelling the complex political and regional forces that played such an important part in the origins and history of the war

this book analyzes attempts by radical spanish republicans to construct an anticlerical nationalist vision of spain focusing in particular on the the mass production by the anticlerical industry of newspapers novels poems cartoons posters postcards and plays put out by republican muckrakers journalists and politicians

this is the first full length study in english of the role of marxist theory in the spanish socialist movement prior to the outbreak of civil war in 1936 in particular the author stresses the intellectual poverty of this aspect of leftwing politics in spain in concentrating on the partido socialista obrero espanol psoe the major organised party of the left prior to the civil war the study seeks to achieve two main aims first to attempt to isolate the political social and intellectual factors which led to a particularly distorted version of marxism which became established in spain at the end of the nineteenth century and second to demonstrate how this particular conception of marxism had a crucial negative impact on the political formulations and fortunes of the psoe between 1879 and 1936 the central argument of the book is that the significance of spanish marxism lay precisely in its poverty since it was this decaffeinated version of the theory which set the parameters within which the psoe formulated its strategy for socialism

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
