stalin fabricated the myth that the germans carried out the katy[□] massacre and the west accepted it while always suspecting the reality in the same way each country tried to forget the more painful memories of its past and construct its own mythology the germans were never taken to task at nuremberg for bombing because the anglo americans virtually carried out a war of annihilation the french gaullist myth was that it was decadent politicians who caused the defeat and that fighting france freed itself in a similar vein the italian resistance was fostered as a myth and used postwar to cover the fascist period of their history british and american popular history tends to portray their countries as the main victors often ignoring the massive russian contribution and generally concentrates on the barbarity of the eastern war much is forgotten and much enhanced both incidents and leaders the italian military historian of this book writes in depth about the italian war so often ignored in western history and tackles the myth of italian cowardice while the british author takes a cold calculated look at anglo american leaders such as montgomery mountbatten clark patton and questions the myth of the special relationship between great britain and the usa as well as the official and unofficial amnesia relating to self inflicted gas wounds in italy

this is a history of 1968 written from a new perspective that of center right student activists in west germany based on oral history interviews and new archival sources it examines the ideas experiences and repertoires of center right students in this age of protest writing these activists back into the history of 1968 and its afterlives including student protest cultural revolt internationalism debates about left wing violence and the terror of the red army faction the memory wars of the 1980s and beyond reveals that this was a broader more versatile and ultimately more

consequential phenomenon than the traditionally narrower focus on a left wing minority allows other 68ers demonstrates that we need a more nuanced history of the 1968 generation and of generational conflict during these years student activists comprised individuals from across the political spectrum who often had very different ideas about what kind of a society they envisaged and how to address the shortcomings of west german democracy 1968 was a moment of intense political conflict but it also played out within the student body and nurtured contrasting identities this book shows that the center right involvement in 1968 had real consequences many of the protagonists of this book would go on to pursue high profile political careers and leave their mark on west german political culture other 68ers therefore sheds fresh light on how west germany s center right dealt with the crisis of hegemony and political identity it experienced in the wake of 1968 how it coped with generational change how it transformed and modernized after losing power at the national level for the first time in 1969 and how it managed to re emerge so successfully in the 1980s

on 24 july 1923 the last treaty ending hostilities in the great war was signed at lausanne in switzerland that treaty closed a decade of violence jay winter tells the story of what happened on that day on the shores of lake geneva diplomats statesmen and soldiers came from ankara and athens from london paris and rome and from other capital cities to affirm that war was over the treaty they signed fixed the boundaries of present day greece and turkey and marked a beginning of a new phase in their history that was its major achievement but it came at a high price the treaty contained within it a compulsory population exchange agreement by that measure greek orthodox citizens of turkey with the exception of those living in constantinople lost the right of citizenship and residence in that state so did muslim citizens of greece except for residents of western thrace this exchange of nearly two million people introduced to the peace conference by nobel prize winner and humanitarian fridtjof

nansen provided a solution to the immense refugee problem arising out of the greek turkish war at the same time it introduced into international law a definition of citizenship defined not by language or history or ethnicity but solely by religion this set a precedent for ethnic cleansing followed time and again later in the century and beyond the second price of peace was the burial of commitments to the armenian people that they would have a homeland in the lands from which they had been expelled tortured and murdered in the genocide of 1915 this book tells the story of the peace conference and its outcome it shows how peace came before justice and how it set in motion forces leading to the global war that followed in 1939

at the end of world war ii the allies faced a threefold challenge how to punish perpetrators of appalling crimes for which the categories of genocide and crimes against humanity had to be coined how to explain that these had been committed by germany of all nations and how to reform germans the allied answer to this conundrum was the application of historical reasoning to legal procedure in the thirteen nuremberg trials held between 1945 and 1949 and in corresponding cases elsewhere a concerted effort was made to punish key perpetrators while at the same time providing a complex analysis of the nazi state and german history building on a long debate about germany s divergence from a presumed western path of development allied prosecutors sketched a historical trajectory which had led germany to betray the western model historical reasoning both accounted for the moral breakdown of a civilised nation and rendered plausible arguments that this had indeed been a collective failure rather than one of a small criminal clique the prosecutors therefore carefully laid out how institutions such as private enterprise academic science the military or bureaucracy which looked ostensibly similar to their opposite numbers in the allied nations had been corrupted in germany even before hitler s rise to power while the argument depending on individual protagonists subject matters and contexts met with

uneven success in court it offered a final twist which was of obvious appeal in the cold war to come if germany had lost its way it could still be brought back into the western fold the first comprehensive study of the nuremberg trials the betrayal thus also explores how history underpins transitional trials as we encounter them in today s courtrooms from arusha to the hague
