the non jazz improvisation series is a concept that germinated in dick weissman s mind while he was attending music school he wrote a 15 piece arrangement of the old square dance tune cripple creek and wanted the trombone to take a solo as part of the arrangement when the trombonist kept playing a bebop solo that was totally unsuitable for the chart dick realized that in addition to the many musicians who do not improvise there are even jazz musicians who don t know how to improvise outside the limits of their own stylistic backgrounds the non jazz improvisation series mostly includes new original tunes that are intended to show how to improvise in many musical styles including bluescountryamerican folklatin americanworld music including south american eastern european and asianodd meters playing in a variety of time signatures new ageclassicalfolk rockin short the books are an encyclopedia of virtually every musical style excluding jazz

this book was written specifically for beginning students working with a

private teacher or in an entry level clarinet class the author emphasizes correct hand positions breath control and tone production needed for a successful start on the instrument all the while encouraging the student to develop fundamental musicianship particular attention is given to the concept of playing in the rich low chalumeau range of the clarinet as well as to playing over the break between registers finger exercises daily warmups a chromatic fingering chart and helpful tips on accessories beginning repertoire and care of the instrument complete this insightful volume essential for any beginning clarinetist's bookshelf

lyrical solos from the british isles is a collection of folk and traditional songs and dances with one hymn and a few original pieces added all with the aspiring young clarinetist in mind the author's 2018 english sonatina is prominently featured the modal and folk song like character of the sonatina is reflected in the clarinet and piano arrangements of the other eleven songs in the collection including such stalwarts as the maiden's lament emerald jig wild mountain thyme and scarborough fair plus two more marshall originals ballad and the highlands the folk influence in this music is further enhanced by the innate lyrical quality of the clarinet in combination with stylistically complimentary piano accompaniment all in all these arrangements of well known tunes together with the author's original compositions and performance notes present an engaging recital repertoire for the young clarinetist
