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what is time does it pass is the future open why do we care philosophy of time the basics doesn't answer these questions it does give you an opinionated introduction to thinking a bit more deeply about them written in a way that assumes no philosophical background from its readers this book looks at central topics in philosophy of time and shows how they relate to other time related topics from theoretical physics without the maths to your own mortality additional questions include in what way is time different to space how long is the present does the theory of relativity show time doesn't pass what makes time have a direction or arrow can you be harmed by your own death allowing the reader to think more deeply about time this book begins to untangle some of the most difficult knots in all of philosophy it also provides practical advice to prospective time travelers

this anthology of essays on the work of david kaplan a leading contemporary philosopher of language sprang from a conference themes from kaplan organized by the center for the study of language and information at stanford university the book contains sixteen papers by such distinguished contributors as robert m adams roderick chisholm nathan salmon and scott soames and includes kaplan's hitherto uncollected paper demonstratives which has for twenty years been one of the most influential pieces in the philosophy of language these essays examine a broad range of themes related to kaplan's work some address his work directly while others are independent discussions of issues provoked by kaplan's thought

this book is the first edited collection of papers on the work of one of the most seminal and profound contemporary philosophers over the last five decades. Kit Fine has made thought provoking and innovative contributions to several areas of systematic philosophy including philosophy of language, metaphysics and the philosophy of mathematics as well as to a number of topics in philosophical logic. These contributions have helped reshape the agendas of those fields and have given fresh impetus to a number of perennial debates. Fine's work is distinguished by its technical sophistication, philosophical breadth and independence from current orthodoxy. A blend of sound common sense combined with a virtuosity in argumentation and constructive thinking is part and parcel of Kit Fine's lasting contributions to current trends in analytic philosophy. Researchers and students in philosophy, logic, linguistics and cognitive science will benefit alike from these critical contributions to Fine's novel theories on meaning and representation, arbitrary objects, essence, ontological realism and the metaphysics of modality and will come away with a better understanding of the issues within contemporary analytic philosophy with which they deal.

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Conceptual Realist Theories of Predication Chapter IV 4 centers on an important class of expressions used for predication in connection with quantities: mass expressions. This chapter reviews the most well known approaches to mass terms and the ontological proposals related to them. In addition to quantification and predication, matters of reference have constituted the other overriding theme for semantic theories in both philosophical logic and the semantics of natural languages. Chapter IV 5 of how the semantics of proper names and descriptions have been dealt with in recent theories of reference. Chapter IV 6 is concerned with the context dependence of reference, in particular with the semantics of indexical expressions. The topic of Chapter IV 7 is related to predication as it surveys some of the central problems of ascribing propositional attitudes to agents. Chapter IV 8 deals with the analysis of the main temporal aspects of natural language utterances. Together these two chapters give a good indication of the intricate complexities that arise once modalities of one or the other sort enter on the semantic stage in philosophy. Chapter IV 9 deals with another well known topic: logic presupposition, an issue on the borderline of semantics and pragmatics. The volume closes with an extensive study of the liar paradox and its many implications for the study of language, as for example self-reference, truth concepts and truth definitions.
