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central to the repertoire of western art music since the 18th century the symphony has come to be regarded as one of the ultimate compositional challenges surprisingly heretofore there has been no truly extensive broad based treatment of the genre and the best of the existing studies are now several decades old in this five volume series a peter brown explores the symphony from its 18th century beginnings to the end of the 20th century synthesizing the enormous scholarly literature brown presents up to date overviews of the status of research discusses any important former or remaining problems of attribution illuminates the style of specific works and their contexts and samples early writings on their reception the symphonic repertoire provides an unmatched compendium of knowledge for the student teacher performer and sophisticated amateur the series is being launched with two volumes on the viennese symphony volume iv the second golden age of the viennese symphony brahms bruckner dvorák mahler and selected contemporaries although during the mid 19th century the geographic center of the symphony in the germanic territories moved west and north from vienna to leipzig during the last third of the century it returned to the old austrian lands with the works of brahms bruckner dvorák and mahler after nearly a half century in hibernation the sleeping viennese giant awoke to what some viewed as a reincarnation of beethoven with the first hearing of brahms s symphony no 1 which was premiered at vienna in december 1876 even though bruckner had composed some gigantic symphonies prior to brahms s first contribution their full impact was not felt until the composer s complete texts became available after world war ii although dvorák was often viewed as a nationalist composer in his symphonic writing his primary influences were beethoven schubert and brahms for both bruckner and mahler the symphony constituted the heart of their output for brahms and dvorák it occupied a less central place yet for all of them the key figure of the past

remained beethoven the symphonies of these four composers together with the works of goldmark zemlinsky schoenberg berg smetana fibich janáček and others are treated in volume iv the second golden age of the viennese symphony covering the period from roughly 1860 to 1930

thirty years after his death fritz reiner s contribution as a conductor as a teacher of leonard bernstein among others and as a musician continues to be reassessed music scholar and long time friend philip hart has written the definitive biography of this influential figure

musicology having been transmitted as a compilation of disparate events and disciplines has long necessitated a magic bullet a unified field theory so to speak that can interpret the steady metamorphosis of western art music from late medieval modality to twentieth century atonality within a single theoretical construct without that magic bullet discussions of this kind are increasingly complicated and to make matters worse the validity of any transformational models and ideas of the natural evolution of styles is questioned and even frowned upon today as epitomizing a grotesque teleological bigotry going against current thinking henry burnett and roy nitzberg claim that the teleological approach to observing stylistic change is still valid when considered from the purely compositional perspective the authors challenge the traditional understanding of development and advance a new theory of eleven pitch tonality as it relates to the corpus of western composition the book plots the evolution of tonality and its bearing on style and the compositional process itself the theory is not based on the diatonic aspect of the various tonal systems exploited by composers rather the theory is chromatically based the chromatically inflected octave being the source not only of a highly ingenious developmental dialectic but also encompassing the moment to moment progression of the musical narrative itself even the most profound teachings of schenker and the often startlingly original and worthwhile speculations of riemann tovey dahlhaus and others

still provide no theory of development and so are ultimately unable to unite the various tendrils of the compositional organism into a unified whole burnett and nitzberg move beyond existing theory and analysis to base their theory from the standpoint of chromatic pitch fields these fields are the specific chromatic pitch choices that a composer uses to inform and design a complete composition utilizing

for students learning the principles of music theory it can often seem as though the tradition of tonal harmony is governed by immutable rules that define which chords tones and intervals can be used where yet even within the classical canon there are innumerable examples of composers diverging from these foundational rules drawing on examples from composers including j s bach mozart beethoven schubert mendelssohn chopin brahms and more bending the rules of music theory seeks to take readers beyond the basics of music theory and help them to understand the inherent flexibility in the system of tonal music chapters explore the use of different rule breaking elements in practice and why they work introducing students to a more nuanced understanding of music theory

research indicates that aural skills are vital in developing musical expertise yet the precise nature of those skills and the emphasis placed upon them in educational contexts merit closer attention and exploration this book assesses the relevance of aural in a university music degree and as a preparation for the professional career of a classical musician by way of the discussion of four empirical studies two main areas are investigated firstly the relationship between university music students aural ability and their overall success on a music degree programme and secondly the views of music students and professional musicians about aural and its relevance to their career are analysed the subject is investigated particularly in the light of the

current socio educational background of the past fifty years which has greatly influenced the participation of music and the study and development of musicianship many related issues are touched upon as part of the research for this project and these emerge as relevant topics in the discussion of aural apart from students and musicians views on training and singing aspects considered include the role of improvisation memorisation and notation examinations absolute pitch and the affinity with language all of which have a part to play in the debate about the importance of aural

the internationally distinguished scholars who have contributed to this timely book were asked to take part in a collaborative act of demystification a reconsideration of the eschatological ideas of the last fin de siècle the 1890s in the light of the critical thought of the 1990s their essays draw upon a range of approaches and are broadly interdisciplinary all are characterised by the realisation that with a century's hindsight the late 1800s should be seen not so much as a period of decadence as of discovery and growth

drawing on the fields of dramaturgy music theory and historical musicology this book answers a question about twentieth century music why does tonality persist in opera even after it has been abandoned in other genres

while scholars agree that the works of the napoleonic era such as the eroica symphony or fidelio embody enlightened revolutionary ideals of progress freedom and humanism beethoven s later works have attracted less political commentary rumph contends that the later works show clear affinities with a native german ideology that exalted history religion and the organic totality of state and society he claims that as the napoleonic wars plunged europe into political and economic turmoil beethoven s growing antipathy to the french mirrored the experience of his romantic contemporaries rumph maintains that beethoven s turn inward is no pessimistic retreat but a positive affirmation of new conservative ideals

franz schubert 1797 1828 is now rightly recognized as one of the greatest and most original composers of the nineteenth century his keen understanding of poetry and his uncanny ability to translate his profound understanding of human nature into remarkably balanced compositions marks him out from other contemporaries in the field of song schubert was one of the first major composers to devote so much time to song and his awareness that this genre was not rated highly in the musical hierarchy did not deter him throughout a short but resolute and hard working career from producing songs that invariably arrest attention and frequently strike a deeply poetic note schubert did not emerge as a composer until after his death but during his short lifetime his genius flowered prolifically and diversely his reputation was first established among the aristocracy who took the art music of vienna into their homes which became places of refuge from the musical mediocrity of popular performance more than any other composer schubert steadily graced viennese musical life with his songs piano music and chamber compositions throughout his career he experimented constantly with technique and in his final years began experiments with form the resultant fascinating works were never performed in his lifetime and only in recent years have the nature of his experiments found scholarly favor in the unknown schubert contributors explore schubert s radical modernity from a number of

perspectives by examining both popular and neglected works chapters by renowned scholars describe the historical context of his work its relation to the dominant artistic discourses of the early nineteenth century and schubert s role in the paradigmatic shift to a new perception of song this valuable book seeks to bring franz schubert to life exploring his early years as a composer of opera his later years of ill health when he composed in the shadow of death and his efforts to reflect i
