having outlined a theory of bullshit and falsehood harry g frankfurt turns to what lies beyond them the truth a concept not as obvious as some might expect our culture s devotion to bullshit may seem much stronger than our apparently halfhearted attachment to truth some people professional thinkers won t even acknowledge true and false as meaningful categories and even those who claim to love truth cause
