using a human rights approach the book analyses the dynamics in the application of minority policies for the preservation of cultural and linguistic diversity in russia despite russia s legacy of ethno cultural and linguistic pluralism the book argues that the putin leadership s overwhelming statism and promotion of russian patriotism are inexorably leading to a reduction of russia s diversity using scores of interviews with representatives of national minorities civil society public officials and academics the book highlights the reasons why russian law and policies as well as international standards on minority rights are ill equipped to withstand the centralising drive toward ever greater uniformity while minority policies are fragmented and feeble in contemporary russia they are also centrally conceived which is exacerbated by a growing democratic deficit under putin crucially in today s russia informal practices and networks are frequently utilised rather than formal channels in the sphere of diversity management informal practices the book argues can at times favour minorities yet they more frequently disadvantage them and create the conditions for the co optation of leaders of minority groups a dilution of diversity the book suggests is not only resulting in the loss of russia s rich cultural heritage but is also impairing the peaceful coexistence of the individuals and groups that make up russian society

this volume centres around concepts of personal and cultural authenticity as they play out in various contexts of foreign language teaching and learning worldwide the chapters cover a wide range of contexts and disciplines including both theoretical and empirical work together they comprise both a

rigorous analysis of authenticity in language teaching and a step away from notions of native speakerism and cultural essentialism with which it is often associated written by a group of scholars working across several continents the chapters offer diverse perspectives regarding the role language plays in processes of personal growth learning development self actualisation and power dynamics the book addresses the theoretical and philosophical nature of authenticity while remaining grounded in the teaching and learning of languages with authenticity viewed as a practical concern that guides our actions and beliefs the book will be of interest to scholars researchers and students of authenticity as well as foreign language teachers interested in the theoretical underpinnings of their practice

a history of education in modern russia is the first book to trace the significance of education in russia from peter the great s reign all the way through to vladimir putin and the present day individual chapters open with an overview of the political social diplomatic and cultural environment of the period in order to orient the reader dowler then goes on to analyse the aims of education initiatives in each era before considering the ways in which russians experienced education both as students and as teachers each chapter concludes with an assessment of the outcomes and consequences of education policies in the period both the successes and failures as well as the impact of education on the cultural social economic and ultimately political environments the chronologically arranged book also traces and then summarises underlying key themes like the tension between an open system of education and an estate based system the push and pull between utility and the broader goal of human development and the effects of centralized authoritarian control that for much of the period limited local initiative and starved the regions of adequate resources

then revived after a hiatus of over two decades from the 1970s to the 1990s with the founding of the orthodox parish of apostles saints peter and paul opaspp at the turn of the twenty first century this study demonstrates how the opaspp has become a vital provider of knowledge about russian language and culture as well as a religious institution serving both heritage and convert believers the community formed by and around the opaspp is important to foster sino russian relations based on individual to individual contact and mutual exposure to chinese and russian cultures in a region of china which allows spiritual and social diversity with minimal political constraints

the russian house an examination of post soviet russian culture in the times of putin examines russian society as considered by the russian people this study recognizes the political economic and social structure of post soviet russia in the 2010s era given that the russian citizenry the ethnic and the civil still desires and recognizes the need for reform while still relying on a host of ideas which russian society and culture reflexively fall back on this book will examine categorizations as separated into five co equal constructs that this book will posit to be axiomatic of russian culture and worthy of consideration in further view of the possibility for russia to one day become a stable and prosperous country without authoritarianism bloodshed militarism or excess nationalism
