the westminster shorter catechism was one of the three documents to emerge from the westminster assembly in the 1640s being the shortest of the documents this particular catechism was written for the specific purpose of providing the most concise summary of biblical doctrine using the historic question answer format this catechism has been among the most popular for helping families in presbyterian and reformed churches to memorize the faith once and for all delivered to the saints

the westminster shorter catechism a concise summary of christian doctrine has served as a foundational teaching tool for the presbyterian and reformed traditions for centuries this edition pairs each question and answer with relevant scripture passages providing a comprehensive biblical basis for the catechism s teachings whether used for personal study family devotions or church education this resource offers a clear and accessible guide to the essential truths of the christian faith

generations of christians have found the westminster shorter catechism to be a wonderful treasury of spiritual gold it outlines the core christian beliefs and the essential characteristics of christian living in a way that enlightens the mind and inspires the heart its most famous statement that our chief end is to glorify god and enjoy him for ever is widely recognized as a piece of timeless wisdom sadly though the wisdom of the westminster shorter catechism is increasingly hard for many people today to appreciate with the passage of time its beautiful 17th century english has become further and further removed from the language we use every day this brief book aims not only to address this problem by putting the catechism into modern english but likewise to highlight the carefully arranged structure of the catechism a structure that in itself contains a great deal of wisdom to achieve this the catechism is divided into sections and a few notes to help explain it are given may god use it to help a new generation glorify and enjoy him

the westminster confession of faith is a reformed confession of faith in the calvinist theological tradition although drawn up by the 1646 westminster assembly largely of the church of england it became and remains the subordinate standard of doctrine in the church of scotland and has been influential within presbyterian churches worldwide in 1643 the english parliament called upon learned godly and judicious divines to meet at westminster abbey in order to provide advice on issues of worship doctrine government and discipline of the church of england their meetings over a period of five years produced the confession of faith as well as a larger catechism and a shorter catechism for more than three centuries various churches around the world have adopted the confession and the catechisms as their standards of doctrine subordinate to the bible the westminster shorter catechism also known simply as the shorter catechism or wsc was written in the 1640s by english and scottish divines the assembly also produced the westminster confession of faith and the westminster larger catechism the three documents are considered by many protestants to be the grandest doctrinal statements to come out of the english reformation completed in 1647 it was presented to the long parliament on 14 april 1648 the purpose of the shorter catechism is to educate lay persons in matters of doctrine and belief the wsc is in a simple question and answer format to facilitate memorization typically parents and the church would use the shorter catechism to train their children in the ways of the lord new converts are also given the wsc as well as the confession of faith and holy scripture to study various denominations have used the westminster confession and catechism to instruct their members

this is a simple introductory commentary on the westminster shorter catechism will be especially useful for self study of the catechism but may be used also to teach the catechism
