forced to travel to america to help his cousin charles wynn earl of lonsdale find an american heiress to wed in order to shore up his family estate that is in desperate need of funds reginald himself has no interest in finding an heiress to marry but when poppy s grandmother asks him to give etiquette lessons to poppy he swiftly discovers he may be in for much more than he bargained for

when miss beatrix waterbury s chicago bound train ride is interrupted by a heist mr norman nesbit a man of science who believes his research was the target of the heist comes to her aid despite the fact that they immediately butt heads they join forces to make a quick escape upon her arrival in chicago beatrix is surprised to discover her supposedly querulous aunt gladys shares her own suffragette passions encouraged by gladys to leave her sheltered world beatrix begins working as a salesclerk at the marshall field and company department store when she again encounters norman on a shopping expedition he is quickly swept up in the havoc she always seems to attract but when another attempt is made to part norman from his research papers and it becomes clear beatrix s safety is also at risk they soon discover the curious way feelings can grow between two very different people in the midst of chaos

status but money didn't always buy them happiness daisy goodwin in the daily mail one of library journal's best historical fiction books of 2011

this book examines the marriages of british peers to american women within the context of the opening up of london and new york society and the growing competitiveness for high social status in london american women were often blamed for the growing hedonism and materialism of smart society and for poaching in the marriage market they were invariably described as frivolous vain and calculating a description which points to the simmering anti american sentiment in britain it was even suggested that titled americans were having a detrimental effect on the british peerage because of their failure to produce male heirs a brilliant analysis of the reasons why american women were viewed pejoratively not only in terms of anti american feeling and the social transformation of the british upper class but also the threat of women who did not appear to conform to aristocratic notions of a peeress's duties as a wife and mother originally published in 1989 this book has unique appendices listing details of peer marriages in this 1870-1914 period

in this sweet historical romance a british noble's reluctant american bride discovers that their match is more than perfect england 1889 though she stands to inherit her grandfather's fortune clementine maccoish prefers her work as a schoolteacher to the gaiety of high society but when her pretty cousin runs off with a charlatan it falls to clementine to fulfill her grandfather's wish and marry into english nobility loyal to a fault she agrees to leave california for dreary england where she will marry a man she's never met on a sleepless night in london clementine is drawn to a nearby garden by the sound of a fountain only to rescue a handsome stranger from drowning in it she's stunned to discover the man is none other than the earl of fencroft the man she's conveniently betrothed to the earl has a reputation for being a man of mystery and he is less than forthcoming about what led to his strange and perilous predicament intrigued by his secrets clementine wishes to find out the truth before she walks down the aisle to wed him
