the contributors investigate the inter relationships between migrant remittances and the family in asia they argue that in the context of asian transnational labour migration where remittances tend to become a primary currency of care the making or breaking of the family unit is mainly contingent on how individuals handle remittance processes

this book provides a multidisciplinary analysis of the links between migration and remittances the role of remittances in influencing migration decision is explored in relation to economic development education the labour market and social factors the impact of remittances on migration is examined from a global perspective with a focus on both specific countries and larger regions such as the european union and the former soviet states the challenges in managing migration flows are also discussed alongside the impact of covid 19 on migration and policy suggestions are made for the efficient management of labour migration this book aims to offer a comparative analysis of the impact of remittances resulting from labour migration and foreign direct investment on the economic growth it will be relevant to researchers and policymakers interested in labour and migration economics

this thesis explores the impacts of labour migration on development in myanmar the central ambition of this thesis is to challenge existing work on the migration development nexus by analysing the context specific factors that structure and effect particular outcomes of migration in particular i pay attention to the role of migration pathways intermediaries household structures and migration policy in producing particular types of migrants to do this i adopted a follow the people and follow the thing methodology which relied on survey n 459 and interview n 71 data both involved burmese migrant workers across the income spectrum but interviews were also conducted with key stakeholders such as remittance recipients in yangon myanmar employment agents multilateral organisations and non governmental organisations this multi sited methodology allowed me to track migratory and remittance sending practices across space grounding findings in verbal reconstructions of pre migration livelihoods everyday practices of migrants in singapore and finally through remittances back to the household in myanmar using bourdieu s theory of practice to dissect migrant and household behavioural drivers this thesis demonstrates how the relationship between migration and development is not straightforward but results from dynamic livelihood strategies and demands issues around employment rights in singapore social protection in myanmar household cultures of filial piety and communal structures of risk sharing and donation are particularly salient i found that migration and remittances do have a positive effect on households but they fail to address underlying livelihood constraints in turn this thesis contributes to an emergent literature on migration precarity and temporality

international migration is a dynamic global phenomenon that has been drawing increasing attention from both scholars and policymakers over the last few decades it is particularly relevant to south asia since the region is a vast source of sojourner migrant labour as well as home to permanent immigrant and diaspora communities the chapters brought together in this volume provide insights into the study of international migration diaspora engagement and remittances in south asia in particular they analyse the implications of this phenomenon in relation to development and shed light on migration and diaspora led development in two sections firstly remittance induced development and secondly diaspora induced development the geographic focus of the volume is the global south asian emigrant population who live outside the region this volume demonstrates that international migration remittances and development offer an exciting field of academic study as well as a vibrant area of policy study its multi disciplinary dimensions enlarge its scope and applicability across several domains as such this volume offers an important contribution to the growing field of international migration in both the academic and policy spheres

in recent years a large number of ethiopians are travelling to various countries as labour migrants the republic of south africa and the oil rich gulf countries have emerged as major destinations for many documented as well as undocumented ethiopian labour migrants the majority of the migrants send a substantial amounts of money back to the country for different purposes out of this the largest share comes through informal channels bypassing banks and other money transfer institutions the use of informal means of money transfer is problematic as it does often violate government financial regulations both in the sending and receiving countries in addition the use of informal channels denies the country valuable foreign exchange income this monograph examines the various channels that ethiopian labour migrants in the republic of south africa and the middle east use to send remittance money to their families and the respective advantages and drawbacks thereof it also looks at how remittance money is utilised by receiving families and its socio economic impacts

the relationship between migration development and remittances in lesotho has been exhaustively studied for the period up to 1990 this was an era when the vast majority of migrants from lesotho were young men working on the south african gold mines and over 50 percent of households had a migrant mineworker since 1990 patterns of migration to south africa have changed dramatically the reconfiguration of migration between the two countries has had a marked impact on remittance flows to lesotho the central question addressed in this report is how the change in patterns of migration from and within lesotho since 1990 has impacted on remittance flows and usage

as measured by its per capita income nepal is one of the poorest countries in the world with large parts of its population trapped in poverty within a stunning but difficult to control natural environment under these conditions since the wake of the 21st century international labour migration and the associated remittances of large amounts of foreign exchange have rapidly gained influence on the country s economic and social development triggered by internal disturbances in particular economic downturn and political upheavals as well as external dynamics which boosted an uprising international demand for unskilled labour while there is hardly any basic dissent about the short to mid term positive growth effect for nepal s economy surprisingly little is known about the consequences of this form of livelihood security at the individual household level apart from some anecdotal evidence although neither policy makers nor ngos may effectively craft their strategies without considering this phenomenon this book was developed from an alumni workshop held in kathmandu in 2015 where focusing on this knowledge gap wide ranging original research about the consequences of family members absence and the receipt of remittances was presented moving on from this starting point the authors further elaborated their work to make it accessible to a broader public and exploitable as a resource for policy making and follow up research in addition this volume includes detailed facts and figures about outmigration from and inflow of remittances to nepal with a view to long term development implications of international migration it also considers the gain of knowledge and access to international academic networks brought into the country by returned scholars the editor of the volume béatrice knerr is a professor of development economics affiliated to the university of kassel germany where until 2015 she was heading the department of development economics migration and agricultural policy demap afterwards she has served as guest professor at the universidad autonoma de yucatan uady in merida mexico and at the college of economics of hue university vietnam presently she is on contract with the brawijaya university of
