this book is a critique of cambridge school historical contextualism as the currently dominant mode of history of political thought drawing upon michael oakeshott s analysis of the logic of historical enquiry while acknowledging that the early cambridge school work represented a considerable advance towards genuinely historical histories of political thought this work identifies two major historiographical problems that have become increasingly acute the first is general an insufficiently rigorous understanding of the key concept of pastness necessarily presupposed in historical enquiry of all kinds the second is specific to histories of political thought a failure to do justice to the varieties of past political thinking especially differences between ideology and philosophy in addressing these problems the author offers a comprehensive account of the history of political thought that establishes the parameters not just of histories of ideological thinking but also of the much disputed character of histories of political philosophy since rethinking history of political thought in oakeshottian terms requires resisting current
