an under examined question for social scientists is whether migrant communities are less likely to support institutions for managing common pool resources as common property a significant body of literature suggests that a high rate of migration undermines institutional processes in local communities however the likelihood of successful common property institutions in migrant communities remains poorly understood for example although prominent explanations emphasize the past based determinants of collective action for common property management such as the core relationships of reputation trust and reciprocity some studies suggest that new immigrant communities with no prior interactions can support institutions for managing common resources in this article i hypothesize that new immigrant communities are less likely to engage in the collective action of supporting common property institutions for forestry resource management accordingly such collective action is engendered by relationships of reputation trust and reciprocity those core relationships are developed through communal interactions over long periods and new immigrant communities have not had time to engage in such interactions as to develop the core relationships to test these hypotheses i use mixed method research design to study efforts at locally supporting national forestry regulations among ugandan communities with varying proportions of immigrants and prospective out migrants that are confronting the degradation of adjacent forest reserves evidence from survey data on 293 randomly selected heads of households suggests that immigrant communities are less likely to support forestry regulations specifically new immigrant communities with low prospects of out migrating are less supportive of forestry regulations than old communities with low prospects of out migrating also there is no significant difference in support for forestry regulations between new immigrant communities with low prospects of out migrating and transitory communities with high prospects of out migrating by implication migrant communities are less supportive of common property institutions because their past based experiences exert more influence on such support than their future based expectations

preserve their own sense of history and identity van nuyss shows that although racism and social control agendas permeated americanization efforts in the west americanizers sustained their faith in education as a powerful force in transforming immigrants into productive citizens he also shows how some westerners especially in california believed they faced a racial frontier unlike other parts of the country in light of the influx of hispanics and asians so that westerners became major players in the crafting of not only american identity but also immigration policies the mystique of the white pioneer past still maintains a powerful hold on ideas of american identity and we still deal with many of these issues through laws and propositions targeting immigrants and alien workers americanizing the west makes a clear case for regional distinctiveness in this citizenship program and puts current headlines in perspective by showing how it helped make the west what it is today
