this book is about the various places and ways that uncertainty shows up for parents who having left or altered the faith they once knew now must decide what to give their kids it s about church attendance bible memorization school choices and sex talks it s about forging new paths in racial justice and creation care while the intractable voices in your head call you a pagan marxist for doing so after the spectacular implosion of her ministry career bekah mcneel was left disillusioned and without the foundation of certainty she had built her life on but rather than leaving the christian faith altogether she hung out around the edges began questioning oversimplified categories of black and white that she had been taught were sacred and became comfortable living in gray areas while starting a new career in journalism then she had kids from the moment someone asked if she was going to have her first child baptized bekah began to wonder if the conservative evangelical christianity she grew up with was really something she wanted to give her children that question only became more complicated when she had her second child months before white evangelicals carried donald trump to victory in the 2016 presidential election soon bekah found that other parents were asking similar questions as they broke with their fundamentalist religious upbringing and took on new values could they raise their kids to live with both the security of faith and the freedom of open mindedness to value both scripture and social justice to learn morality without shame in bringing up kids when church lets you down bekah gathers voices from history scholarship and her own community to guide others who like her are on a quest to shed the false certainty and toxic perfectionism of their past to become better healthier parents while still providing strong spiritual foundations for their children she writes with humor and empathy providing wise reflections but not glib answers on difficult parenting topics while reminding us that we are not alone even when we break away from the crowd

taking charge making change gives voice to generations of native people from crow creek lower brule and other reservations in north dakota and south dakota who shaped a school originally designed to foster catholicism and assimilation local initiatives and collaboration transformed the catholic stephan mission boarding school into the crow creek tribal school which now features both tribal traditions and american educational programs through archival research and interviews with parents graduates teachers and staff at crow creek and the surrounding community robert w galler jr places native students at the heart of the narrative demonstrating multifaceted family connections at a nineteenth century on reservation religious school that evolved into a tribally run institution in the 1970s he shows numerous ways that community members worked with catholic leaders and ultimately transformed their mindsets and educational approaches over nearly a century while recognizing the many challenges and tragedies that native students endured galler highlights the creativity collaborations and contributions of the students and graduates to their communities taking charge making change shows how individuals and families helped to found the school maintain enrollment secure funding and influence school policies its graduates went on to serve with distinction in the u s military earn advanced degrees after college join and lead tribal councils in north and south dakota help their communities push back against federal policies and continue to run their own education system

music in the western notes from the frontier presents essays from both film studies scholars and musicologists on core issues in western film scores their history their generic conventions their operation as part of a narrative system their functioning within individual filmic texts and their ideological import especially in terms of the western s construction of gender sexuality race and ethnicity the hollywood western is marked as uniquely american by its geographic setting prototypical male protagonist and core american values music in the western examines these conventions and the scores that have shaped them but the western also had a resounding international impact from europe to asia and this volume distinguishes itself by its careful consideration of music in non hollywood westerns such as ravenous and the good the bad and the ugly and in the easterns which influenced them such as yojimbo other films discussed include wagon master high noon calamity jane the big country the unforgiven dead man wild bill there will be blood and no country for old men contributors ross care corey k creekmur yuna de lannoy k j donnelly caryl flinn claudia gorbman kathryn kalinak charles leinberger matthew mcdonald peter stanfield mariana whitmer ben winters the routledge music and screen media series offers edited collections of original essays on music in particular genres of cinema television video games and new media these edited essay collections are written for an interdisciplinary audience of students and scholars of music and film and media studies

the story of the reformed church s relationship to native americans is one of persistence and optimism in the face of overwhelming odds unfortunately it s also a story that reflects all too well the sad record of u s dealings with america s first inhabitants in this frank well balanced account of the reformed church s native american missions and churches leroy koopman recounts the spiritual journey of the jesus road shared by reformed and native american christians taking the jesus road outlines how government and church often cooperated with each other in implementing shifting policies that allowed the native peoples little or no voice in their own destiny koopman does not hesitate to point out how early missionaries often equated the christian faith with white culture but also gives credit for their tireless efforts to

seek a better life for the people they were serving much of the book is devoted to the stories of particular ministries including the six native american congregations that remain a vital part of the reformed church today
