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presents full translations of over 50 documents from the files of what would have been the foreign office of the hittite empire among them are treaties diplomatic letters royal edicts and records concerning relations of the hittites with their anatolian and syrian vassals and with the great powers of the time and region among other uses they can help biblical scholars understand the historical background of the covenant the first edition was published in 1995 annotation copyrighted by book news inc portland or

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the first comprehensive survey of the world s oldest known legal systems this collaborative work of twenty two scholars covers over 3 000 years of legal history of the ancient near east each of the book s chapters represents a review of the law of a particular period and region e g the egyptian old kingdom by a specialist in that area within each chapter the material is organized under standardized legal categories e g constitutional law family law that make for easy cross referencing the chapters are arranged chronologically by millennium and within each millennium by the three major politico cultural spheres of the region egypt mesopotamia and anatolia and the levant an introduction by the editor discusses the general character of ancient near eastern law

this volume challenges patrimonialism as a political model for the ancient near east by engaging with letters and legal texts concerning royal women at late bronze age ugarit demonstrating women s pivotal roles in the exercise of power and then bringing these insights to bear on the hebrew bible the book offers a new vision of how women figure in ancient political systems through an analysis of royal letters legal verdicts and regional records it examines overt claims and implicit anxieties concerning the pivotal

roles of royal women three case studies from late bronze age ugarit reveal that a single woman functioning in a range of modalities mother daughter sister and wife brokered a network of relationships among a range of men patrimonialism depended on the political polyvalence of women texts from ugarit attest to this reality and the biblical royal women of the house of david amplify its significance this analysis of women s activity within and among royal households is productive not only for the study of the late bronze age levant but also as a model for analogous inquiries into ancient societies and other systems in which data are thin and patrimonialism widely in evidence royal women at ugarit is suitable for students and scholars working on women and gender in the ancient near east as well as those interested in the political realm of the late bronze age and the intersections of biblical literature with other ancient texts

in created equal joshua berman engages the text of the hebrew bible from a novel perspective as a document of social and political thought he proposes that the pentateuch can be read as the earliest prescription on record for the establishment of an egalitarian polity

the hittites in the late bronze age became the mightiest military power in the ancient near east yet their empire was always vulnerable to destruction by enemy forces their anatolian homeland occupied a remote region with no navigable rivers and they were cut off from the sea perhaps most seriously they suffered chronic under population and sometimes devastating plague how then can the rise and triumph of this ancient imperium be explained against seemingly insuperable odds in his lively and unconventional treatment of one of antiquity s most mysterious civilizations whose history disappeared from the records over three thousand years ago trevor bryce sheds fresh light on hittite warriors as well as on the hittites social religious and political culture and offers new solutions to many unsolved questions revealing them to have been masters of chariot warfare who almost inflicted disastrous defeat on rameses ii at the battle of qadesh 1274 bce he shows the hittites also to have been devout worshippers of a pantheon of storm gods and many other gods and masters of a new diplomatic system which bolstered their authority for centuries drawing authoritatively both on texts and on ongoing archaeological discoveries while at the same time offering imaginative reconstructions of the hittite world the author argues that while the

development of a warrior culture was essential not only for the empire's expansion but for its very survival this by itself was not enough the range of skills demanded of the hittite ruling class went way beyond mere military prowess while there was much more to the hittites themselves than just skill in warfare this engaging volume reveals the hittites in their full complexity including the festivals they celebrated the temples and palaces they built their customs and superstitions the crimes they committed their social hierarchy from king to slave and the marriages and pre nuptial agreements they contracted it takes the reader on a journey which combines epic grandeur spectacle and pageantry with an understanding of the intimacies and idiosyncrasies of hittite daily life
