wasn't quite six feet tall his slim body and the smile on his face almost put me at ease i thought this man couldn't possibly frighten anyone and yet i couldn't forget the number of homicides in which he had been involved i wanted to see into the mind of the man who planned and participated in the most horrible homicides that the cartel had carried out in their war against the state
