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what happens to homeless and runaway adolescents when they become adults this is the

first study that follows homeless youth into young adulthood and reviews the mental health consequences of runaway episodes and street life the adolescents were interviewed every three months for three years from their mid teens to their early twenties the study documents the psychological consequences associated with becoming adults when missing the critical developmental tasks of adolescence the authors report high levels of psychological problems associated with victimization prior to and after running away these victimization experiences shape the behaviors of these young people affecting their relationships with others and their chances of conventional adjustment across time the more successful their adaptation to street life and the street economy the more barriers to conventional adult life emerge the distress including self mutilation and suicidal behaviors among this population is examined as well as the impact street life has on future relationships education and employment nutritional and health problems are also explored along with the social and economic impact of this population on society as such the book provides insight about why the current prevention and treatment programs are failing in an effort to help policy makers modify approaches to adolescent runaways intended as a supplementary text for undergraduate and or graduate courses on homelessness high risk youth social deviance adolescence and or emerging adulthood taught in departments of psychology human development sociology social work and public health this compelling book will also appeal to anyone who works with homeless adolescents

considers the issue of young people s early housing histories in the context of a range of government policy initiatives aimed at the group

young homeless people takes a broad approach to the distressing phenomenon of youth homelessness while politicians researchers and the media focus on the more visibly homeless those sleeping rough in city centres or staying in hostels this book also considers the young homeless hidden in local communities it places young people s experiences of homelessness in the context of their biographies as a whole and makes policy and practice recommendations based on the views and preferences of young homeless people themselves

this accessible guide provides information and advice on how to understand the needs of these young people and how to ensure they are supported effectively it combines the latest research and practice to establish what works best when helping young homeless people and provides insights into their world through diary excerpts and interviews

the chronically homeless face a stark reality lack of access to support systems adequate shelter and sustenance with little hope for something better for young people however life

on the street may be merely a temporary stage in their lives this book tells of homelessness among young people the causes and their attitudes to the various problems they face young homeless people describe a life in which they lose their privacy the possibility to satisfy their basic needs and often their self respect in order to survive the latter half of the book considers what happens when these young people return to society and how they navigate difficulties as they attempt to leave their past behind often the struggle is not solely one of coping with the stigma of their experience rather they must face the legacies that linger long after their lives have turned a corner drug addiction criminal records and accumulated debt based on interviews with homeless people in prague homelessness as an alternative existence of young people paints an authentic picture of this social group and documents the often unseen social consequences of the transformation to capitalism from communism

this straightforward reference surveys the knowledge base on homeless runaway and thrown away children and adolescents and makes concrete recommendations for policy and practice it is a comprehensive volume that covers new state legislation in the u s dealing with runaway and homeless youth the book s ecological approach grounds readers in the demographics of this diverse population family and other risk factors for leaving home and alternative arrangements such as foster care and the survival skills homeless young people use to sustain themselves chapters cover a gamut of physical psychological and social problems from drug abuse to depression to stis with special attention paid to the multiple difficulties faced by lgbt street youth and street youths experiences with the legal and justice systems the author also assesses established and emerging interventions used with runaway youth and the effectiveness of policy initiatives dealing with improving conditions for youth on the streets and at risk included in the coverage runaway youth at the time of their disappearance food insecurity and related problems among homeless and runaway youth substance use among homeless and runaway adolescents runaway and homeless sexual minorities court responses to runaway offenses and other juvenile status violations street youth in different countries presenting the complex situation as it stands and with clear suggestions for action runaway and homeless youth is a valuable resource for family therapists sociologists social workers school administrators health professionals police judges and other criminal justice professional along with professionals involved in young people s well being and policy making initiatives

an increasing number of families are becoming homeless often as a result of domestic violence which leaves women and their school age children without homes this multidisciplinary volume is the first to look at the variety of problems encountered by this group and to propose strategies for managing those problems

adolescent homelessness is a growing problem that results in a variety of health challenges this text is a practical resource designed to promote effective interdisciplinary health and social care interventions targeting adolescents who are homeless or at risk for homelessness it is based on extensive interdisciplinary experience reviews of pertinent research and insights and contributions of leading professionals who are directly involved in the care of these young people divided into four main sections section 1 chapters 1 7 section one is a review of the structure and professional involvement of program models targeting youth experiencing or at risk for homelessness to encourage broader understanding and utilization of principles and practices underlying effective programs and identify replicable components section 2 chapters 8 16 section two is clinically focused with recommendations for working with adolescents and youth experiencing homelessness and interventions for common and significant medical and mental health conditions and substance use disorders section 3 chapter 17 reviews international agreements regarding stabilization and care of refugee youth and families description of experiences of refugee children and youth in developed countries and an outline of conditions from which refugee youth and families have left section 4 chapters 18 and 19 engagement of homeless youth in research and future research directions to address needs of youth experiencing homelessness written by experts from a variety of disciplines clinical care for homeless runaway and refugee youth is a first of its kind text for physicians social workers public health workers and any other individual that works directly with these vulnerable populations

drawing on a broad range of international studies this book looks in detail at how youth homelessness is variously defined measured and explained as well as discussing the solutions which are usually proposed for it yet this book is more than simply a description of youth homelessness it uses original material to show how youth homelessness like other issues can be differently presented by agencies the media academics politicians and by those directly affected in this case young homeless people themselves

this book explores the identities embodied experiences and personal relationships of young people experiencing homelessness and analyses these in relation to the material and symbolic position that youth homelessness occupies in modern societies drawing on empirical research conducted in both urban and rural areas the book situates young people's experiences of homelessness within a theoretical framework that connects embodied identities and relationships with processes of social change the book theorises a symbolic economy of youth homelessness that encompasses the subjective aesthetic and relational dimensions of homelessness this theory shows the personal interpersonal and affective suffering that is caused by the relations of power and privilege that produce contemporary

youth homelessness the book is unique in the way in which it places youth homelessness within the wider contexts of inequality and social change whilst contemporary discussions of youth homelessness understand the topic as a discrete social problem this book demonstrates the position that youth homelessness occupies within wider social processes inequalities and theoretical debates addressing theories of social change in late modernity and their relationship to the cultural construction of youth these theoretical debates are made concrete by means of an exploration of an important form of contemporary inequality youth homelessness

young people place and identity offers a series of rich insights into young people s everyday lives what places do young people engage with on a daily basis how do they use these places how do their identities influence these contexts by working through common sense understandings of young people s behaviours and the places they occupy the author seeks to answer these and other questions in doing so the book challenges and re shapes understandings of young people s relationships with different places and identities the textbook is one of the first books to map out the scales themes and sites engaged with by young people on a daily basis as they construct their multiple identities the scales explored here include the body neighbourhood and community mobilities and transitions and urban rural settings and how these all shape and are shaped by young people s identities each chapter explores how social identities such as race gender sexuality class disability and religion are constructed within particular contexts and influenced by multiple processes of inclusion and exclusion these discussions are supported by details of the research methods and ethical issues involved in researching young people s lives drawing upon research from a range of contexts including europe north america and australasia this book demonstrates the complex ways in which young people creatively shape contest and resist their engagements with different places and identities the range of issues topics and case studies explored include ethical and methodological issues in youth research youth subcultures experiences of home territorialism youth and crime political engagement and participation responses to global issues engagements with different institutional contexts negotiating public space the transition to adulthood drinking cultures the author explores these issues through blending together original empirical research theory and policy individual chapters are supported by key themes project ideas and suggested further reading details of key authors journals and research centres and organisations are also included at the end of the book this textbook will be pertinent for undergraduate and postgraduate students and academic researchers interested in better understanding the relationships between young people places and identities

the terms wellbeing empowerment and agency are common parlance in policy and practice

with children young people and families cyf yet are often misused or not fully understood further there is a disconnect between these abstract concepts and tangible practice with cyf this book bridges the theory practice divide offering a clear and definitive guide to concepts and practical ways to develop cyf wellbeing it examines the concept of wellbeing and its intrinsic relationship to social justice both theoretically and through case study material and locates these practices within critical pedagogy the book highlights a range of practice with cyf of various ages in formal and non formal learning situations engaged in a range of different programmes including learning reduction from offending social action and tackling targeted needs each chapter highlights relevant policy research and practice examples to ensure that the book is relevant to a variety of readers this book will benefit students and practitioners who work with young people to realise wellbeing and to embed critical pedagogy in their practice it also provides a frame of reference to critically engage in policy analysis and is essential reading for social workers teachers police support officers and anyone working to support cyf to become empowered
