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this volume provides an up to date and comprehensive coverage of second language learning the focus throughout the book is primarily on language learning but each chapter also discusses the implications for teaching and assessment thus informing both understanding and practice the book contains nine sections which aim to organise and reflect different dimensions of the diverse and complex scope of learning english as a second or additional language four themes which permeate the chapters are learning and learners learning and language learning and language development learning and learning context the 36 chapters are up to date and authoritative written by experts in the field the content is accessibly written with questions for discussion and follow up reading suggestions provided

the research in this volume takes account of the context of policy promoting chinese as a second language csl in several countries and regions australia east asia and south east asia and the wider social context of multilingual and multicultural societies furthermore this book reports results of two research studies which investigated how to develop effective strategies to promote learners motivation and the motivational developments of adult learners in real life settings helping to overcome gaps in this under researched area findings reported in this book have been scientifically examined and found to be effective in enhancing the learners csl proficiency increasing their learning motivation and addressing the need for a diversity of targeted approaches to csl most are applicable across preschool to secondary levels the theoretical grounding of this research work represents a new direction for research in teaching chinese as a second language

this unique volume focuses on the development of chinese as a second language csl teachers in the global context it addresses the specific issues and challenges faced by csl teachers and demonstrates international practices in the field it also provides a comprehensive examination of their multifaceted professionalism from diverse perspectives with the rise of china as a political and economic power learning csl has increasingly gained its popularity in a global context according to the chinese international education foundation by 2023 the number of registered chinese language learners exceeded 12 5 million due to the shortage of teachers the ministry of education in china launched the international chinese language teachers volunteer program in 2004 by 2021 more than 61 000 volunteer chinese language teachers had been dispatched to more than 151 regions and countries many more overseas universities colleges and higher institutes now have established csl programmes at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels to cultivate local csl teachers however as the number of csl learners continues to grow the need for high quality chinese language teachers has become more urgent than ever responding to csl teachers challenges of delivering chinese language and culture to learners from diverse language and cultural backgrounds this book explores four interrelated themes 1 csl teachers professional development in the global context 2 csl teachers motivation agency and identity 3 csl teachers knowledge and practice in multicultural and multilingual contexts and 4 csl teachers technological literacy and agency in the digital era with its focus on both the internal and external complexities of csl teacher development the book offers timely insights and practical guidance for researchers educators
