policies and strategies for healthy ageing in selected countries are also reviewed this monograph ends with a highlight on the design and development of a community model for healthy ageing providing insights to the achievement of sustainable healthy ageing with reference to the sustainable development goal sdg 3 a valuable resource to governments politicians academics and practitioners it is intended for formulating future directions of relevant research and the design and implementation of interventions for the promotion of healthy ageing in the post pandemic era
