the first collection and translation into english of the earliest biographical accounts of galileo s life this unique critical edition presents key early biographical accounts of the life and work of galileo galilei 1564 1642 written by his close contemporaries collected and translated into english for the first time and supplemented by an introduction and incisive annotations by stefano gattei these documents paint an incomparable firsthand picture of galileo and offer rare insights into the construction of his public image and the complex intertwining of science religion and politics in seventeenth century italy here in its entirety is vincenzo viviani s historical account an extensive and influential biography of galileo written in 1654 by his last and most devoted pupil viviani s text is accompanied by his letter to prince leopoldo de medici on the application of pendulum to clocks 1659 his 1674 description of galileo s later works and the long inscriptions on the fa ade of viviani s florentine palace 1702 the collection also includes the adulatio pernicioosa a latin poem written in 1620 by cardinal maffeo barberini who as pope urban viii would become galileo s prosecutor as well as descriptive accounts that emerged from the roman court and contemporary european biographers featuring the original texts in italian latin and french with their english translations on facing pages this invaluable book shows how galileo s pupils friends and critics shaped the galileo myth for centuries to come and brings together in one volume the primary sources needed to understand the legendary scientist in his time

since 1971 the international congress for neo latin studies has been organised every three years in various cities in europe and north america in august 2009 uppsala in

sweden was the venue of the fourteenth neo latin conference held by the international association for neo latin studies the proceedings of the uppsala conference have been collected in this volume under the motto litteras et artes nobis traditas excolere reception and innovation ninety nine individual and five plenary papers spanning the period from the renaissance to the present offer a variety of themes covering a range of genres such as history literature philology art history and religion the contributions will be of relevance not only for scholarly readers but also for an interested non professional audience

this book presents a collection of essays by prominent young researchers and established scholars on the medieval reception of aristotle s topics in the latin arabic and hebraic traditions as well as on its late ancient sources in alexander of aphrodisias and boethius the book thus provides a fruitful engagement with the late ancient to medieval reception of the topics a tradition that has been understudied in recent scholarship the collected contributions revisit the reception of the topics focusing on historical analyses of dialectics as a general method of argumentation and as a scientific method the authors studied in this book range from well known figures such as alexander boethius buridan and avicenna to the lesser known radulphus brito judah ben shlomo ha kohen and ibn tumlus this book is an important contribution to the study of argumentation theory in the historical past and is of interest to scholars of the historical development of dialectical argumentation and argumentation theorists

this is the first book length study of the relationship between benedetto croce 1866 1952 giovanni gentile 1875 1944 guido de ruggiero 1888 1948 and robin george collingwood 1889 1943 though the relationship between these highly influential philosophers has often been discussed it has never been studied comprehensively on the basis of published and unpublished writings this study carefully reconstructs their debate on the relationship between thought and action following their explorations of art history philosophy and action in the context of the first world war and the rise of fascism and nazism this book unveils the hidden past of contemporary philosophy of history and divulges the last secret of collingwood s italian connection

the first ever multivolume treatment of the issues in legal philosophy and general jurisprudence from both a theoretical and a historical perspective the work is aimed at jurists as well as legal and practical philosophers edited by the renowned theorist enrico pattaro and his team this book is a classical reference work that would be of great interest to legal and practical philosophers as well as to jurists and legal scholar at all levels the work is divided the theoretical part published in 2005 consisting of five volumes covers the main topics of the contemporary debate the historical part consisting of six volumes volumes 6 8 published in 2007 volumes 9 and 10 published in 2009 volume 11 published in 2011 and volume 12 forthcoming in 2015 accounts for the development of legal thought from ancient greek times through the twentieth century the entire set will be completed with an index volume 7 the jurists philosophy of law from rome to the seventeenth century edited by andrea padovani and peter stein volume 7 is the second of the historical volumes and acts as a complement to the previous volume 6 discussing from the jurists perspective what that previous volume discusses from the philosophers perspective the subjects of analysis are first the roman jurists conception of law second the metaphysical and logical presuppositions of late medieval legal science and lastly the connection between legal and political thought up to the 17th century the discussion shows how legal science proceeds at every step of the way from rome to early modern times as an enterprise that cannot be untangled from other forms of thought thus giving rise to an interest in logic medieval theology philosophy and politics all areas where legal science has had an influence volume 8 a history of the philosophy of law in the common law world 1600 1900 by michael lobban volume 8 the third of the historical volumes offers a history of legal philosophy in common law countries from the 17th to the 19th century its main focus like that of volume 9 is on the ways in which jurists and legal philosophers thought about law and legal reasoning the volume begins with a discussion of the common law mind as it evolved in late medieval and early modern england it goes on to examine the different jurisprudential traditions which developed in england and the united states showing that while coke s vision of the common law continued to exert a strong influence on american jurists in england a more positivist approach took root which found its fullest articulation in the work of bentham and austin

the italian author giovanni gentile 1875 1944 occupied a radical position among philosophers of the first half of the twentieth century he tried in earnest to revolutionize idealist theory developing a doctrine that retained the idealist conception of the thinking subject as the centre and source of any intelligible reality while eschewing many of the unwarranted abstractions that had pervaded earlier varieties of idealism and led their adherents astray given his great prominence during his

lifetime it is perhaps remarkable that gentile is so little discussed and even then so poorly understood in the english speaking world few of his works have ever been translated into english and these represent only a fraction of his great corpus and the many topics discussed therein this neglect is partly explained by his close association with the partito nazionale fascista national fascist party of which he remained a loyal member and supporter between 1923 and his assassination in 1944 the volume comprises eleven essays seven of these are new pieces written especially for thought thinking and are intended both to contribute to ongoing debates about gentile s philosophy and to indicate just a few of its many aspects that continue to draw the attention of philosophers political theorists and intellectual historians these are supplemented by new english translations of four of gentile s shorter works selected to offer some direct insight into his ideas and style of writing

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
