To this end, Professor Shi proposes a dual method through which the norms found in WTO agreements and in UNESCO cultural instruments may be brought into alignment. The first highlights the compatibility of cultural policy measures with trade obligations on a domestic level. The second suggests potential linkages between the WTO rules and the UNESCO convention from the perspectives of treaty interpretation.
