at the heart of the empire japan won and then lost in the pacific war was manchukuo a puppet state created in northeast china in 1932 not unlike india for the british manchukuo was the crucible and symbol of empire for the japanese in this book the first social and cultural history of japan s construction of manchuria louise young studies how people at home imagined experienced and built the empire that so threatened the world

in 1970 nine members of a japanese new left group called the red army faction hijacked a domestic airliner to north korea with dreams of acquiring the military training to bring about a revolution in japan the north korean government accepted the hijackers who became known in the media as the yodog<sup>9</sup> group based on the name of the hijacked plane and two years later they announced their conversion to juche north korea's new political ideology little was heard from the exiles until 1988 when a member of yodog<sup>9</sup> was unexpectedly arrested in japan and communications with the group opened up in the context of his trial as a former red army faction member journalist k<sup>9</sup>ji takazawa made several trips to north korea reestablished his ties to the group's leader takamaro tamiya and helped to publish the group's writings in japan after kim il sung revealed that yodog<sup>9</sup> members had japanese wives takazawa published a book of interviews with the women but in the process became suspicious about the romantic stories they told he also wondered about the members who were missing and learned more details in long private conversations with tamiya after tamiya's sudden death in 1995 takazawa launched his own investigation of what the group had actually been doing for two decades even traveling to europe to follow traces there an example of superb investigative journalism destiny the secret operations of the yodog<sup>9</sup> exiles offers k<sup>9</sup>ji takazawa's powerful story of how he exposed the yodog<sup>9</sup> group's involvement in the kidnapping and luring of several young japanese to north korea as well as the truth behind their japanese wives presence in the country takazawa's careful research was validated in 2002 when the north korean government publicly

acknowledged it had kidnapped thirteen japanese citizens during the 1970s and 1980s including three people whom takazawa had connected to the yodog<sup>9</sup> hijackers embedded in his pursuit toward what truly happened to the yodog<sup>9</sup> members is takazawa s personal reflection of the 1970s a decade when radical student activism swept japan and what it meant to those whose lives were forever changed

after world war ii japanese intellectuals believed that world history was moving inexorably toward bourgeois democracy and then socialism but who would be the agents the active subjects of that revolution in japan intensely debated at the time this question of active subjectivity influenced popular ideas about nationalism and social change that still affect japanese political culture today in a major contribution to modern japanese intellectual history j victor koschmann analyzes the debate over subjectivity he traces the arguments of intellectuals from various disciplines and political viewpoints and finds that despite their stress on individual autonomy they all came to define subjectivity in terms of deterministic historical structures thus ultimately deferring the possibility of radical change in japan establishing a basis for historical dialogue about democratic revolution this book will interest anyone concerned with issues of nationalism postcolonialism and the formation of identities

among the revolutionary movements which shook the nineteenth century world the change of government in japan in 1868 occupies a special place a new dynamic ruling class provoked the overthrow of the old rule of the shogun and in a few years the visible structure of feudal society disappeared the founders of the new meiji rule had themselves been warriors and thought they were able to resist foreign pressure but very quickly they adopted western dress gave their country a modern army built railways and contributed to establishing a great empire the nature of this transformation has been regarded by western historians as revolution and restoration two quite contradictory ideas but in this book paul akamatsu clarifies the picture of the forces at work in this conversion of a backward feudal state into a modern power in a few decades
